

Associate Membership - General information.

As an Associate Member you will be able to:

- Display 1 piece of art plus an A4 laminated sheet with other images and contact details below your work. Basic fee £20 a year, payable to Barton Hall Studios.
- Take part and display your work in the 5 open weekends: 1 spring, 3 Open Studios (Sept) and 1 Christmas opening, assist with preparations and invite guests to the preview evenings. If you wish to display more than your 1 entitled piece during these open events, (up to 2 more) will incur a £5 fee, towards the promotional costs of that event.(to be a member of 'Open Studios' is optional).
- Have your own web page on the Barton Hall Studios site with up to 5 images, links and contact details. Subject to a fee.
- Have use of the office facility: computer with broadband, printer, facsimile and telephone at an hourly charge of £1. Call charges additional.

Your name can be added to the waiting list for available studio spaces.

You will receive minutes of any meetings, voting is for studio licence holders only but any input welcome.

There is a studio on site that is available for workshops, demonstrations and classes etc, subject to suitability and availability: Charged at £20 a day, or £10 half day.

For Security reasons access to the building is by appointment only with your contact artist at Barton Hall or Nigel Wicksteed on 07904 515 878.
